#### CHAPTER 1

### PERSONNEL ADVISORY BOARD<sup>1</sup>

**2-101. Creation; duties and powers.** A personnel advisory board is hereby created and the duties and powers of such board shall be as prescribed in the applicable provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, title 6, chapters 30 through 36 and ordinances enacted by the mayor and city council of Elizabethton, Tennessee. (1982 Code, § 1-901)

**2-102. Membership; terms.** The board shall consist of seven members who shall serve for a term of two years, and the terms of the members appointed shall begin on October 5th of each odd numbered year. (1982 Code, § 1-902)

**2-103. Members to serve at pleasure of city council.** All members shall serve at the pleasure of city council and shall serve until their successors are qualified. (1982 Code, § 1-903)

**2-104. By-laws and rules of procedure.** The personnel advisory board is authorized to adopt by-laws and rules of procedure for the conduct of its authorized activities in so far as such by-laws and rules of procedure are not in conflict with laws of the state and ordinances of the City of Elizabethton; and as further established by appropriate resolution of the city council. (1982 Code, § 1-904)

## CHAPTER 2

### ELIZABETHTON PUBLIC LIBRARY<sup>1</sup>

#### SECTION

2-201. Library board to operate.

2-202. Use of library building.

**2-201. Library board to operate.** The council shall elect a board of five (5) members, to be known as the library board, which shall be charged with, and have full authority to see to, the operation of the Elizabethton–Carter County Public Library. At least two (2) members of the library board should be members of the Elizabethton Business and Professional Women's Club, Inc. Also, one or more members of the library board may be a member or members of the council. The term of office for the library board members shall be as follows: two (2) of the initial members shall be elected for a term of one (1) year; the other three (3) initial members shall be elected for two (2) years; thereafter, as the term of each member expires, his successor shall be elected for a two (2) year term. (1982 Code, § 1-601, as amended by Ord. #37-6, Feb. 2001, and Ord. #39-5, June 2003)

**2-202. Use of library building.** The Elizabethton–Carter County Public Library building shall only be used for qualified municipal purposes. The main floor shall be used primarily as a public library. The main floor shall not be used for any other purpose, except that the library board may allow local civic clubs or similar organizations to hold their meetings in the conference room when such meetings will not interfere with the library operation. (1982 Code, § 1-602, as amended by Ord. #39-5, June 2003)
